We are looking for volunteers for several aspects of rescue.. Foster homes of course are always a big need for us...but also very important is we need people to donate 4 hours a month to help us when we go to pet stores to promote our dogs...Racine, Kenosha< Milwaukee, Muskego....we usually go on Saturdays, or any day you can spend the time to set up a table at a pet store and hand out information and talk to people about our rescue...we can supply training, materials and contacts...its more fun if two or more people come and sit together, you don't need lots of knowledge just a willingness to talk to people and interest in rescue...we will supply information and knowledge

## SWHDR SENIOR PROGRAM

We have developed a new policy for the adoption of mature shelties.....Shelties have an average lifespan of 13-15 years with some living much longer.....but many people are wary of adopting an older dog due to health concerns, etc. If you adopt a mature dog from us.. 8 years and older we will support the dog by paying for its yearly vaccinations, heartworm test/preventative, and annual physical....this will be done at our vet but you can do it once a year in the springtime so your travel will be limited....we also will let you adopt a new pet if the senior passes away at no charge...(only one adoption fee) as long as the dog passes away of natural causes...(old age, disease, etc.)or if it is necessary to euthanize the dog because of disease/or documented illness... This program applies to senior dogs presently in our program and all future senior dogs...check the newsletter/website or ask which dogs qualify for the program.....

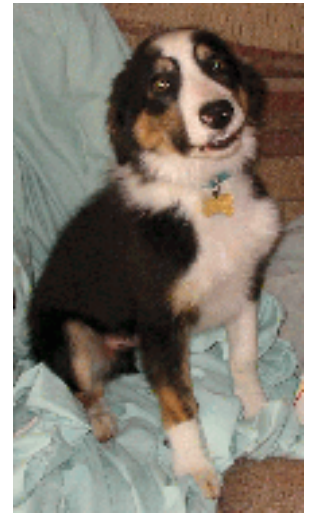
